#### 30 hours Childcare


Parents who were issued with 'temporary codes' may have received a letter from HMRC to invite them to complete a childcare service application to receive their permanent 30 hours code. A permanent code will be needed before the old code's validity date ends. If you have already received your permanent code please bring it in to Mrs Clarke in the school office to continue to receive your funded place. If you have any queries the childcare service helpline will be available to help on 0300 123 4097. Parents will need to reconfirm their eligibility every three months. Parents should receive messages from HMRC about reconfirming their eligibility in the 'Secure messages' section of their childcare account.

We are currently taking application for Nursery for after Easter 2018 and September 2018. Please contact Mrs Clarke in the school office to register your child.

#### **Attendance**


