Earrings

Staffordshire policy is that earrings are not to be worn during PE at all. We are currently updating our school policy which now states that earrings must be removed for PE. We would therefore kindly request that parents/ carers allow their children to have their ears pierced in the summer holidays so that this does not impact on their PE in school. This new policy will be put into action following the Easter holidays. Therefore any child with their ears pierced after this point will need to be able to remove them on the day of PE or not wear them to school on PE days. Children will not be allowed to cover their ears with plasters or tape. If children have their ears pierced during term time they will not be able to take part in physical PE sessions until they are able to remove their earrings. We are sorry for any inconvenience caused but hope that we have given you sufficient notice of this change in policy.
