## Applications for High School

**A reminder that high school applications close on Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> October. If your child is due to transfer to high school in September 2018, please ensure you have applied for a place for your child by this date.**

### Are you eligible for Free School Meals?

We are asking parents/ carers to assess their eligibility for free school meals. Although children in Reception and KS1 are already entitled to universal free school meals, it is vitally important that you register your eligibility for free school meals so that we can claim additional funding for your child whilst they are at this school. This is called 'pupil premium funding'. This funding helps towards purchasing a variety of additional resources to support the education of your children.

Your child could be eligible for free school meals – and accordingly pupil premium – if you receive any of the following benefits:

- Income support
- Income based job seekers allowance
- Income based Employment and Support Allowance
- Child tax credit and no working tax credit with a household income of less than £16,190
- Universal Credit
- The 'guarantee' element of State Pension Credit
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
