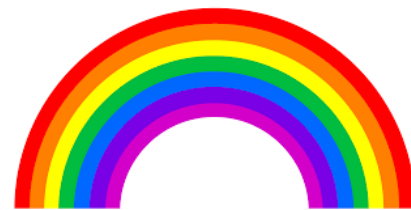
### Forest School
