TT ROCKSTARS NEEDS YOU!

As we're sure you are aware, knowledge and quick recall of multiplication facts (and associated division facts) underpins many mathematical concepts. We've noticed a decline in the use of the TT Rockstars program amongst KS2 children. We would be very grateful if you could encourage your child to play on TT Rockstars on a regular basis to improve their knowledge and recall of multiplication and division facts. By clicking on the Garage tab, children can play games associated with multiplication tables class teachers have set specifically for them. The Studio tab allows children to access games associated with all multiplication and division

facts up to 12 x 12. By playing in the studio ten times, children will then receive a baseline time. The Soundcheck tab gives access to a timed game, involving only multiplication facts. There are 25 questions to answer, giving 6 seconds to answer each question, with a 3 second gap between questions. By playing on these games regularly, children's knowledge and recall of multiplication and division facts has improved significantly.

There will be fortnightly certificates awarded for a variety of targets; most improved time, most coins earned, most times played etc. There will also be class leaderboards produced.

We hope you will support us in encouraging your children to use TT Rockstars regularly.
