MFL at Hayes Meadow

At Hayes Meadow, in MFL, children are taught to develop an interest in learning other languages in a way that is enjoyable and stimulating that encompasses the National Curriculum objectives.

- We encourage children's enjoyment and confidence through quality first teaching.
- Children enjoy learning French and work hard demonstrating positive learning behaviours using the Learning Characters designed by the children to 'be the best we can be'.
- They develop a high-quality languages education through curiosity and deepening their understanding of the world.
- We strive to embed the skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing necessary to enable children to use and apply their French learning using key vocabulary and grammar.
- Our MFL curriculum is designed to progressively develop children skills in languages, through regular taught lessons in Key Stage 2.
- We follow the 'Rigolo' Scheme of work to ensure coverage and progression across school.
- Children visit prior knowledge through retrieval activities to embed key knowledge.
- There are a variety of activities that are matched to the children and provide challenge where appropriate. All learners have carefully designed lessons that are adapted to meet their individual needs, following the SEND code of practice.
- Children in Early Years and KS1 are given opportunities to develop their understanding of languages including French.
- Every academic year, we have an MFL enrichment day to enhance and enrich our pupil's MFL curriculum.
