Maths at Hayes Meadow

Mathematics is an integral part of everyday life. At Hayes Meadow we are committed to ensuring that children can recognise the importance of Maths in the wider world and they are able to use their mathematical skills and knowledge confidently in their lives in a range of different contexts.

- We want our pupils to develop an ability to solve problems, to reason, to think logically and to work systematically and accurately.
- We want children to enjoy Mathematics, be curious and experience success in the subject.
- Teachers reinforce this by having high expectations for all pupils and fostering a positive attitude about Maths.
- New mathematical concepts are introduced using a 'Concrete, Pictorial and Abstract' approach, enabling all children to experience hands-on learning when discovering new mathematical topics and allowing them to have clear models and representations to aid their understanding.
- Arithmetic and basic maths skills are practised daily to ensure key mathematical concepts are embedded and children can recall and apply knowledge rapidly and accurately.
- Children are engaged and challenged in their learning.
- Our Mathematics teaching follows a mastery approach, allowing the majority of pupils to progress through the curriculum content at the same pace.
- Interventions and teacher/TA support are provided where necessary to support those pupils who need it
