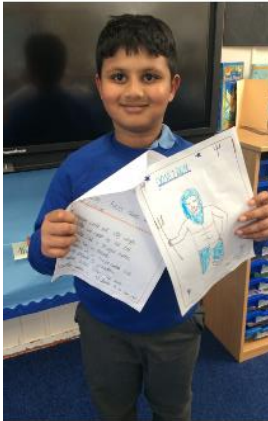
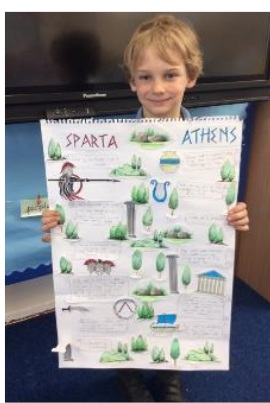
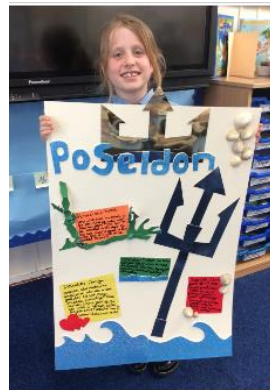


Year 2 – Artwork
