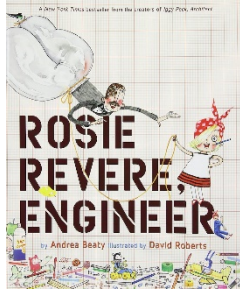


## Year 2 Learning- Autumn 2 2023

### English

We are reading...

**Rosie Revere Engineer!**



We will be using the book to write narratives, instructions, character descriptions and explanations. The children will be using different sentence types and including expanded noun phrases in their work.

We have begun to look at writing in different tenses and have begun to join our letters.

The children have weekly spellings and their test is on Tuesdays.

### Maths

This term we will be focusing on addition and subtraction and shape.

We will be looking at adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers using base ten and the column method.

The children will then move onto shape where they will look at 3D shapes.

We will be looking at the properties of 3D shapes, including the vertices, edges and faces.

### Science

This half term, our science topic is Animals including humans!

We will be looking at different stages in a life cycle for animals including humans. The children will also look at why a balanced diet and good hygiene are important for humans.

### Our Local Area!

History- We are learning about what Handsacre was like 100 years ago and how it is different to the way it is now.

Geography- We will be looking at directional language to describe our local area. We will also be using maps to identify and learn about our closest towns and cities.

## Curriculum

Music- This half term we will be focusing on dynamics and tempo.

RE- Valuing new life: We will be looking at how different groups and religions show that they value new life.

Computing-: Digital photography: Capturing and changing digital photographs for different purposes.

Art: Clarice Cliff: We have been researching Clarice Cliff, looking at who she is and what she's famous for making. We are experimenting with colour, shape and line in the style of Clarice Cliff. We will end the term by making a coil clay pot inspired by Clarice Cliff's pottery.
