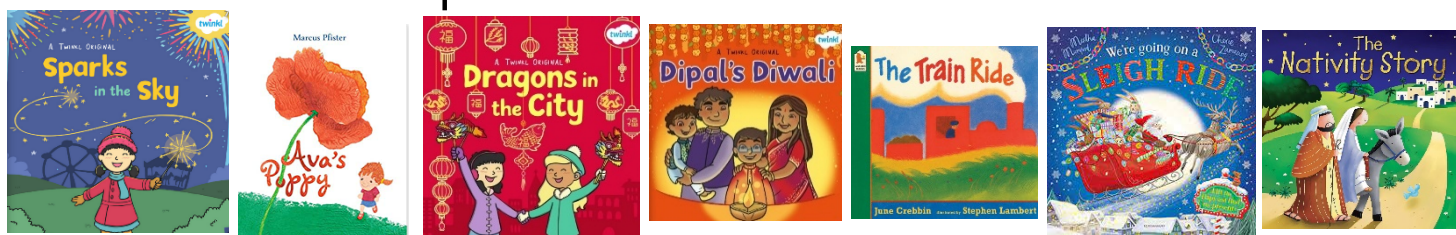


Preschool learning

Our topic this term is Celebrations



We will be learning about Bonfire Night, Remembrance Day, Road Safety, Children in Need, St Andrews Day, Diwali, Christmas and Hanukkah.

Below outlines how the topic links to the EYFS curriculum.

COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE Children listen to stories, asking questions or talking about what they have read (while reading with your child you could encourage them to discuss what they have read and ask questions). Children follow instructions involving several ideas or actions.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT Children will develop and maintain friendships. Children will be confident to try new activities, and say why they like some activities more than others. To know how to make their needs known. Children will be able to share and take turns. They will become increasingly independent in meeting their own needs – toileting and washing their hands. They will be able to talk about brushing their own teeth.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT Children move around in a range of ways, negotiating space. They will handle a range of equipment and tools effectively, including pencils/pens for early writing.

MATHS Children will be able to recognise and write numbers to 5. They will be able to talk about and explore 2D and 3D shapes using their names and talking about their properties – sides, corners, straight, flat and round.

LITERACY Children will be learning to listen attentively. They will be enlarging their vocabulary. They will be able to explore and compare different sounds through playing musical instruments and going on listening walks. Children will be speaking confidently to adults and other children. Children will be singing a range of songs and rhymes and will begin hearing and recognising rhyming words.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD Children will be confident to talk about their environment and similarities and differences with other environments. Children will learn about road safety. Children will be able to talk about their own life and share how they celebrate special events.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN Children will be able to develop their own ideas and express themselves in a variety of ways when sharing information about them. They will be able to join a variety of materials to make different items. They will be confident to explore role play and music. They will develop complex stories into their role play and small world play.
