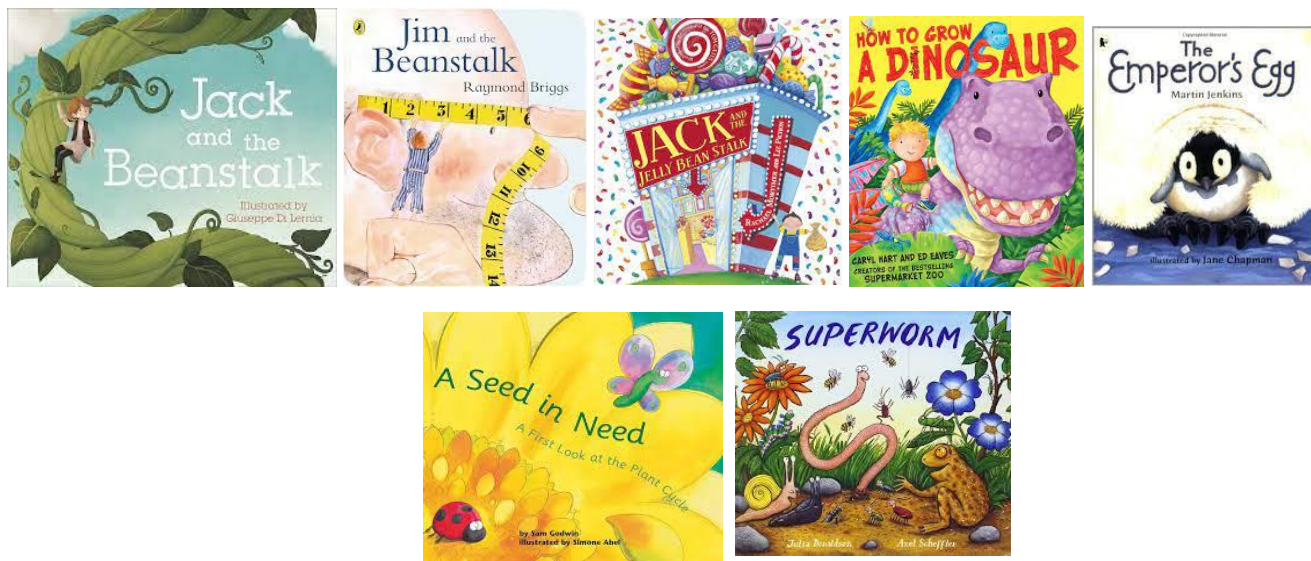


Reception learning Summer 1 2024

Our topic this term is Come Outside, Growth



This half term we our topic is Come Outside, growth.

Below outlines how the topic links to the EYFS curriculum. We will begin our Summer term reading Jack and the Beanstalk and then comparing it to Jim and the Beanstalk and Jack and the Jelly Beanstalk.

COMMUNICATION & LANGUAGE Children will listen to stories about plants, extend their vocabulary to be able to explain how we can help plants to grow. Children will be encouraged to ask questions to find out more and articulate their ideas and thoughts in well-formed sentences. The children will use past and present tense with increasing accuracy.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT This half term children will learn what we need to grow and think about how to care for others and living things. We will continue to work on sharing and turn taking, as well as independently using manners.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT Children will progress towards a more fluent style of moving, with developing control and grace. They will be supported with developing their ability to do buttons and zips independently. The children will develop the foundations of a handwriting style which is fast, accurate and efficient.

MATHS Children will practise counting to 20 verbally and practise adding and subtracting numbers and saying how many they have now. Children will also revisit 2D shapes focusing on manipulating, composing and decomposing shapes.

LITERACY We will re-read familiar and previously read books to build up the children's confidence in word reading, their fluency and their understanding and enjoyment. Children will be supported to form lower-case and capital letters correctly. We will read and write simple short sentences using capital letters and full stops and the re-read what we have written to check it makes sense.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD This half-term we will be exploring the natural world around them, describing what they see, hear and feel whilst outside. The children will plant seeds and learn what they need to grow.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN Children will be encouraged to return to and build on their previous learning, refining ideas and developing their ability to represent them. We will create observational drawings of plants. Children will be encouraged to develop storylines in their pretend play.
