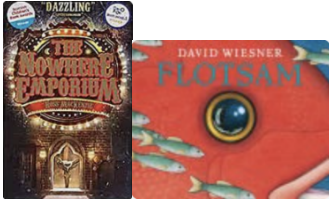


Year 4 Learning Summer Term 2025

English



Our work this term will be based on Flotsam and The Nowhere Emporium. We will be using our inference and deduction skills, predicting, justifying our opinions and summarising in the reading part of the lessons. In writing, we will be composing our own stories based on these 2 books, looking at setting and character descriptions, writing letters and diary entries.

Maths

Decimals – partitioning, comparing, ordering and rounding. Fraction and decimal equivalence.

Money – converting pounds and pence, solving problems involving money.

Time – days, weeks, months. 24-hour clock, converting between analogue and digital times.

Shape – angles, symmetry, triangles, quadrilaterals, coordinates and translations of 2D shapes.

Science

Electricity

Identify and name appliances that require electricity to function. Construct a series circuit. Identify and name the components in a series circuit. Predict and test whether a lamp will light within a circuit. Know the function of a switch. Know the difference between a conductor and an insulator.

Animals including Humans

Identify and name the parts of the human digestive system. Know the functions of the organs in the human digestive system. Identify and know the different types of human teeth. Know the functions of different human teeth.

PE

Outdoor PE on a Tuesday – Athletics. Please make sure children have suitable outdoor PE kits i.e. outdoor trainers, shorts and t-shirt.

Outdoor PE on a Thursday – Rounders and Tennis. Please ensure children have suitable PE kits i.e. outdoor trainers, shorts and t-shirt.

RE/PSHE/Music

RE- Thinking about God - Identify some of the ways in which religions name and describe attributes of God and make links with belief and practice. (Christianity and Hinduism)

Features and patterns of worship: Identify the main features and patterns of an act of worship and talk about the importance of worship for believers. (Christianity and Islam)

PSHE – Me and My Relationships - Feelings of other people, Developing relationships, different types of relationships, Puberty. Me and other People - Similarities and differences, Communities including Britain, Respect and tolerance

Music- We will be continuing to learn to play the violin led by an external teacher.

Art Drawing – Use pastels in a still life drawing in the style of Edgar Degas.

DT - Make a model of a local building with an electrical component.

MFL/Computing

French – Where are you going? Directions and weather. Eating and food, how much do things cost.

Computing – Editing photos and Programming – repetition in shapes and games.
