All 'Live Lessons' will be through Microsoft Teams for Year 1-6.



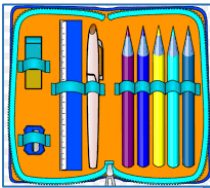
To take part in lessons you must be dressed, wear clothes you would usually wear on a non-uniform day. No pyjamas please.

When joining the lesson...

Be in one of your family rooms e.g. dining room. Not your bedroom.



Be on time for the lesson and wait for the teacher to let you in.



Have all your equipment ready including paper and pencil.

Make sure you are on mute. Only unmute if you are asked to.



When taking part in the lesson...

Behave as you would in the class, listen carefully at all times.



Complete tasks along with the teacher to support your learning.

Do not screenshot any part of the lesson.



During the lesson you can use the chat to answer teachers questions or leave a comment. The chat is only to be used when lessons are on.



At the end of the lesson listen out for any tasks you need to complete before the next lesson.
